<u>LOGISTICS/JUDGES/CASUALTY SIMULATORS INFORMATION</u> - Scenario # 3

(BACKGROUND - NOT TO BE SHARED WITH COMPETITORS)



Scenario Location: Alleyway

Team Info: Your team is at a local business for an open house. While there, a bystander comes running over stating there is an individual that was sleeping in the alley that isn't moving for their truck to come through.

Overall Scenario: Patient found "sleeping" on the ground, with personal belongings close by. Closer inspection; Patient is found laying on ground, unresponsive, with drug

paraphernalia close by. Patient appears unkempt, dirty, and cyanotic. On assessment, the Patient has an infected wound to their Right foot area on their leg needing treatment.

Scenario Set Up:

- Total number of patients:
- Patient #1 Found laying on ground, improves throughout scenario
- Scenario Props: Tents/Tarps, Dirty Needles, Shopping Carts, Random Belongings, Fake Drugs, Spoons, Lighters, Ridiculous Thrift Store Clothes
- First Aid Supplies Required: FA Kit(s), Blankets, PCR's
- MFR Supplies: Oxygen Kit(s), Narcan Trainers, BVM's

Timing Notes:

Team handout/ Scenario background to be given to teams PRIOR to the beginning of the scenario BEFORE the Scenario BEGINS

0 minutes - Scenario BEGINS - "GO, GO, GO."

3 minutes – for the end of the marking of "scene/primary survey"

18 minutes – 2 minutes remaining - for the team's benefit.

20 minutes – Scenario ENDS. Teams may have up to <u>5 minutes</u> to complete their paperwork and submit it to their judge.

25 minutes - Paperwork ENDS. Judges collect PCR immediately and ensure ALL boxes are completed. NO debrief with teams will occur at the Scenario Site. Debrief data will be forwarded to teams through coach contacts in due course after the event.

Judges Marking

- items are scored as either Completed or NOT COMPLETED if Not <u>FULLY</u> completed
- If teams continue to provide patient care (i.e.: finish tying a bandage, etc.) after time is called, that care will be counted as **NOT COMPLETED**.
